- Created systems to track spending and income

Purpose

To create and implement a long-term fundraising strategy that meets the fundraising goals set by the KU board, supports its programming and community, and ensures the sustainability of the organization.

2021 Accomplishments

- Built a donor/constituent database in Neon CRM with 200+ profiles, that manages event registrations, creates an automatic donation receipt for all donations and stores corporate sponsorships and grants
- Raised \$17,000 in grant funding, and over \$11,000 during end of year 2020 campaign
- Created grants calendar, profiles for federal grant applications and documents needed for both grant applications and grant reporting
